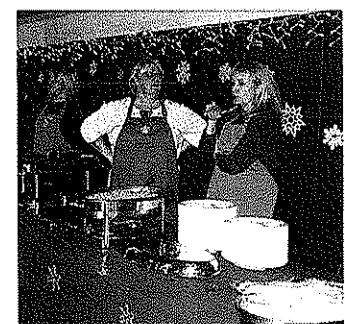

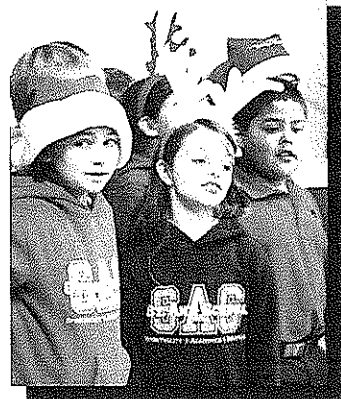

### 3rd and 4th Visit Mary Queen of Angels

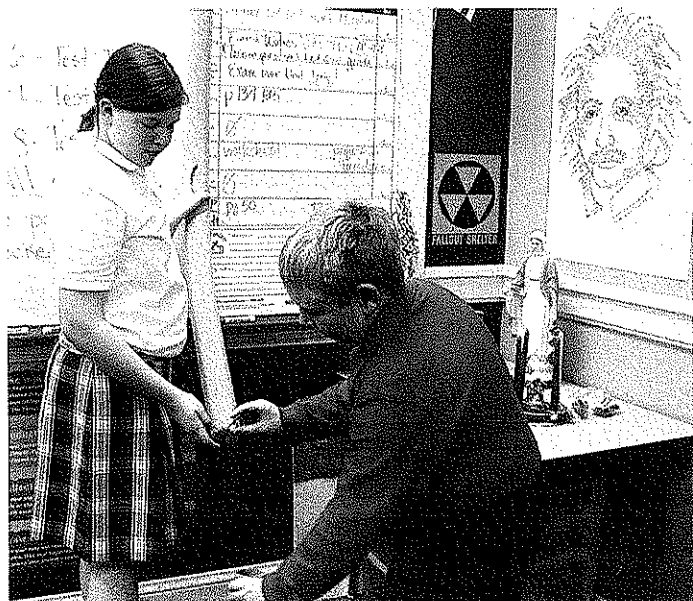


Our 3rd and 4th graders worked with their Service Partner, Mary Queen of Angels Home, as they stopped by to sing and visit with the residents.

Marshmallows were flying around the hallways as 8th graders experimented with various angles on their catapult to score the longest launch.

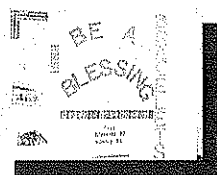


## Important News Items

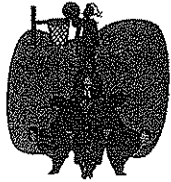
