- A faith-based educational setting open to all children
- Standardized test scores place St. Ann School in the top 2%-4% annually.
- An average of 40% of alums receive honor roll or academic honors in high school, proof that our students are well prepared for the next academic level.
- With a student-teacher ratio of 13:1 we are a small learning community where the students and the adults are able to engage in personalized, meaningful relationships.
- Certified by the State of Tennessee and the Diocese of Nashville, and fully accredited by BOTH Southern Association of Independent Schools (SAIS) and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS).
- Our instructional staff averages 13 years of teaching experience and many hold Master's Degree or higher
- The academic building is completely wireless, facilitating extensive use of laptops throughout the curriculum.
- Our recently renovated main library, our primary grade library, and the classroom libraries house a 10,000 book collection that supports our Accelerated Reading program. This program provides diagnostic information to our teachers and reading practice which has created a "reading culture" at St. Ann School.
- Students receive technology instruction from grades 3-8; including Microsoft Office programs, desktop publishing, digital video editing, and web-page design.
- Every grade, Kindergarten through eighth, receives four days of intensive Spanish instruction per week.
- The school uses an online assessment program called Yearly Progress Pro which allows bi-monthly assess-



ment of academic progress. Why use only a one-time, end of the year assessment?

- Through the Diocesan Athletic League, students can participate in ten different sports options.
- Our arts program includes theatre arts, musical arts and visual arts classes for all grades. Students participate in choirs, group ensemble work, forensics, and theatre productions.
- Middle grade scholars plan and provide a school news show broadcast to each classroom three days per week.
- A theatre arts class is part of the curriculum at every grade. Our goal is to help develop leaders who have strong communication skills.
- Grades 3/4 learn musical recorders, grades 5/6 learn world drumming, and grades 7/8 learn guitar.
- Every class adopts an organization and provides countless hours of service to their partners each year.
- Our onsite before and after school care program is staffed by St. Ann employees and provides homework sessions for students, a real help for working families.
