### Application Procedures—General Information



The best way to understand the qualities of a St. Ann education is to ex-

perience it first hand. Therefore, we suggest you schedule a personalized tour of our campus during school hours. It is our philosophy that there is no one school right for all children. Parents should spend considerable time evaluating the unique needs of their stu-

dent, the needs of the family, and the type educational environment desired for their child. Each school in Nashville is different and parents have the difficult task of matching their needs with the set of components offered by each school.

### Application Procedures—Kindergarten

The formal application process for incoming Kindergarten students begins in Nov.-Dec. with a one-on-one assessment administered by the kindergarten teacher. The assessment is scored in

about one week, after which we will contact you to set up an appointment with the principal to discuss the results of the assessment and complete registration materials.

In early May, your child will spend 2-3 hours in the Kindergarten classroom. This will allow your child to become acquainted with the classroom, new incoming Kindergarten classmates, and the Kindergarten teacher

Parents should spend a considerable amount of time evaluating the unique needs of their student, the needs of their family, and the type of educational environment they want to partner with them in educating their child.

### Application Procedures—Grades 1-8

**STEP ONE:** Schedule a school tour and a meeting with the principal.

**STEP TWO:** After the tour, potential students are invited to spend a day at St. Ann to learn more about our community. Parents need to bring previous report cards and standardized tests on the visitation day. At the conclusion of

the day, parents and the principal will meet to discuss enrollment.

**STEP THREE:** After the enrollment meeting, written notification concerning acceptance will be sent to the applicant, along with an application for the upcoming school year. When the application and \$150 non-refundable application fee is returned to the school,

the student is fully admitted.

**STEP FOUR:** Upon acceptance, the Parish Finance Committee determines tuition rate; tuition payments begin 1 July and end 1 May.

**STEP FIVE:** An orientation will be provided for the parents of newly enrolled students in early August.
