**Feeling a bit overwhelmed by the idea of something so 21<sup>st</sup> century? Here are some guidelines to help you get started:**

- ✓ Go to [www.twitter.com](http://www.twitter.com) and click on “sign up now”.
- ✓ Enter your name, establish a username and password, and enter your e-mail address. Retype security words and click “create my account”.
- ✓ Click “next step friends”, then click “next step others”, then “next step you’re done”.
- ✓ Twitter will send you a confirmation e-mail. Just follow the directions to confirm your account.
- ✓ To set your account to send text messages to your phone, log into Twitter and click on “settings” and then on “mobile”. Turn “device updates” to “on” and follow the directions to set your phone up to receive text messages from Twitter.
- ✓ Go to the school website and click on the link for Twitter “Eagle Tweets” on the home page.
- ✓ Sign into Twitter from here with your new username and password.
- ✓ Click on the “send request” button to request to become a follower of Saint Ann School.
- ✓ Once accepted, log into your Twitter account and click on the link under “following”. Click on the mobile phone icon in the settings column of SASEagles if you wish to receive “tweets” on your phone.
